## An Important COVID-19 Alert

Good afternoon,

Since the email that was sent out earlier this week, we only had the 1 resident test positive. Residents on the main floor were isolated and meals were brought to their rooms.

I spoke with Dutchess County this afternoon and I am happy to report that as of tomorrow, 1/23/22, those residents will be out of quarantine and will resume regular schedules. The individual who tested positive will remain in isolation until Thursday 1/27/2020. That being said, we will resume resident visitations on Thursday 1/27 as well. All visitations will be held in Room 1 only. EVERYONE entering the building must go through the screening process and must wear a mask while in the building. All visitations must be scheduled 24 hours in advance. Please remember that Vassar-Warner Home does have the right to suspend visitation privileges' to those not following the guidelines.

Medical appointments may also resume on the 27th.

We believe that this incident was brought in from a staff member or visitor and could have been catastrophic to everyone at Vassar-Warner Home. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work through this pandemic together, and we are available to answer any questions you may have.
