Good afternoon all. Today we identified 2 more positive cases of COVID 19 at Vassar-Warner Home. After a long day, and many discussions, and with the assistance from Dutchess County Emergency Management, we have decided to shut the building down for 10 days. This will hopefully stop the spread and prevent any new cases.

So what does this mean?

1. All residents must stay in their rooms. Residents who are not COVID positive may use the bathrooms, but only 1 person in the bathroom at all times.
2. All meals will be delivered to each resident's room.
3. Visitation will continue as described in yesterday's email, by appointment only and in an assigned visitation room. However, we strongly encourage you to use Zoom and Facetime for seeing your loved ones. We would be happy to assist with this.
4. All residents must wear a mask when leaving their room.
5. Residents who are negative may leave the building for medical appointments but we strongly urge you not to take them out for leisure, however this is the resident's choice.

If all works the way we hope it will, the 4 people identified Sunday will come off isolation on 9/7 and the rest of the building will come off isolation on 9/9.

I promise to keep you posted if there are any more developments.
